

**Terms and conditions for membership of
Borough Market's Cookbook Club**

1. The following terms shall have the following meanings:
"We" means The Borough Market Southwark and "Our" and "Us" is interpreted accordingly
"You" means the member of the Cookbook Club and "Your" is interpreted accordingly
"Event" means an event operated by us at Borough Market under the name "The Cookbook Club"
"Organiser" means Angela Clutton or such other person as shall be notified by Us to You as being the organiser of the Event.

Membership

2. You must be 16 years of age or over.
3. In joining the Cookbook Club You will send us your name, email and address. We will not share those details with any third parties and will comply with the privacy statement on our website:

However we may contact You on occasion with details of events being run by Us, or on our behalf, at Borough Market.

Attending an Event

5. The Event will take place at The Cookhouse in Borough Market. The Cookhouse is accessible via stairs only; there is no disabled access.
6. Tickets are non-refundable and non-exchangeable. If You can no longer make it to the Event, please notify Us at least 7 days ahead and We will try to re-allocate the ticket. A refund will only be applicable if a replacement guest is found.
7. A limited number of free tickets are available for members of the Cookbook Club residing within the SE1 postcode on proof of residential address. Free tickets are allocated at Our sole discretion.

8. A copy of the recipe book chosen for the Event will be available for on the spot reference at Our Information Office at Borough Market. However in order to avoid any infringement of copyright in the book You may not copy any part of it in any way.
9. We may take photographs and/or film of the Events, so You should let the Organiser know in advance if You would prefer not to be included.
10. We retain the right to refuse entry to an Event.
11. If We have to cancel the Event due to unforeseen circumstances, We will arrange a new date as soon as possible.

Preparing for an Event

12. Once You have acquired your ticket for the Event the Organiser will contact You by email with guidance as to how to prepare for the Event and You will be expected to comply with her requirements.
13. Any dish you make for the Event must be prepared in a hygienic environment. Please keep in mind the dish you make is for the consumption of others and You must maintain high standards of cleanliness through its preparation.
14. Dishes must be stored in a refrigerator until the evening of the Event.
15. We will have made a note of allergens contained in any dishes, as detailed in the recipes in the selected books, so you must tell the Organiser if you deviate from a recipe in any way. This is important for the safety of all guests at the Event.
16. If the Organizer shall deem any dish to be unsafe for consumption, We reserve the right to withdraw it from the selection of offerings at the Event.
17. We accept no responsibility for any food consumed at the Event and We are not liable for any ill effects which might arise as a result.
